### Who are we?

Fullwood Packo Dairy Group design, manufacture and distribute state of the art milking equipment worldwide and for over 85 years have been recognised as being at the forefront of milking technology. We have a strong European customer base and are now looking for a Production Operator to help support our Assembly team for a Fixed Term Contract for six months.

### Key Duties

- Operating across a variety of work-centres as required in order to help with production material throughout within the Assembly areas
- Flexibility to work in areas such as:
  - Bench Assembly – building subcomponents into parts required for sales orders to our customers, or that then are fitted into our milking machines
  - Electronics Assembly – building subcomponents with circuit boards, soldering, wiring, crimping, programming and testing software onto the circuits
  - Robotics Assembly – building and testing of the Merlin milking machine from the bare frame upwards with wiring, tubing, and general assembly of components

### Safety

- Safety is the number one priority within this business.
- As a Production Operator it is your responsibility to work in a safe manner.
- You will report any safety issues to your Team Leader as soon as they are discovered, and you will support your Team Leader in any investigations that are required.
- It is your responsibility to help drive the safety culture and performance of this business forward by having a proactive attitude towards safety.
- Work within the guidelines of all SWI's and Risk Assessments at all times to ensure the safety and well-being of yourself and your work colleagues.
- Ensuring the working environment is always clean and safe .

### Quality

- Raise any issues of nonconformity with products you are handling to your Team Leader and work with them to help drive out these non-conforming issues.
- Assist your Team Leader in the creation of Standard Work Instructions, Standard Operating Procedures and Risk Assessments for all tasks within your Section. Operating methods and procedures are designed to eliminate safety issues, operating problems and improve product quality.
- Good knowledge of process and product quality standards and documentation, and a good eye for detail.

- You will ensure that your work complies to all required specifications, drawings, etc. as required, and you will conduct quality inspections as required, feeding back issues to your supplier (be it internal departments or external suppliers via the Procurement Team) until they are resolved.
- Maintain good quality documentation by having the ability to understand and complete required production documentation to an audit ready standard according to instructions.
- Assist your Team Leaders in all Continuous Improvement activities.

### Productivity

- Competent in the skills required to operate various tools and equipment within a manufacturing environment, including drills, soldering irons, tappers, wire crimping, and general assembly.
- Willing to build knowledge of new skills and tasks to further skills base.
- Liaising with Team Leaders and Engineering to raise any issues or suggest process improvements.
- Achieve or better targeted machine or process output times while maintaining product quality.
- Ensure any faults are reported to minimise waste and downtime.

### Delivery

- Contribute to achieving 100% on time, in full (OTIF) deliveries to our customers, both external and internal.

### People

- Assist your fellow team members as required to achieve objectives set by the team leaders.
- Undertake training as required to develop your skills and increase flexibility within the Logistics team.
